SENIOR FARMERS MARKET VOUCHER DISTRIBUTION



Senior Farmers Market Vouchers will be distributed at the Senior Connections offices on Tuesday, June 18, 2019 beginning at 9:00 a.m.

You must be eligible to receive Senior Farmer Market Vouchers. Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- You must be 60 years of age or older, or Native American 55 years of age or older.
- You must be a resident of Douglas County Wisconsin.
- Your household income is at or below 185% of the federal poverty guidelines listed below.

For each additional household member, add \$682 monthly, \$8,177 annually.
